Questions on Divine Healing

Question; (from Rhonda Jackson)

We pray for something by thanking Him, and I claim it. But yet I hear a sister in Christ pray and ask for prayer for months. Thanking Him and thanking Him. I want to say, let it go and let God work it out. I would offend her by saying that.

Why is she doing that?

Lack of faith?

Also, I hear some of the same prayers from you. Are you doing the same thing that I feel like I am roped into?

Am I being disobedient by praying repetition prayers?

Personal prayers should not be different than praying for other people, but yet I know that they do not get it or receive it.

We need to operate in love for them, but how does repetition prayer come in?

Answer:

Great questions. The prayer of faith should be prayed once and done unless you did not believe you received it at the time of prayer, then pray again until you HAVE BELIEVED.

As to thanking Him, that is great as you have believed it is done, so you thank Him for having done it.

As to cancer and demon activity, you will many times need to command them more than once to leave as they tend to come back, especially when

the person is not in absolute faith, thus seems like praying over and over, but really, you are rebuking Satan off again and again due to his persistence.

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, **when ye pray, believe** that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. Mark.11.24

What about the widow woman and the unjust judge?

And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man: And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man; Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith. And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
